**Title:** Kingdom Prayer (Part 4)

Text: "forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors." Matthew 6:12

Target: God is Provider

## I. A <u>REQUEST</u> for Forgiveness: "forgive"

- **A. Positional (Justification):** In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace. (Ephesians 1:7)
- **B. Relational (Fellowship):** If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. (1 John 1:9)
- II. A <u>REASON</u> for Forgiveness: "debts"
  - **A.** Miss the Mark (archery term): For all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God. (Romans 3:23)
  - B. Trespass (slipped up): And you were dead in trespasses and sins. (Ephesians 2:1)
  - C. Transgression (crossed the line): But if you show partiality you are committing sin and are convicted by the law of transgressors (James 2:9)
  - **D.** Lawlessness (no regard to the law): Everyone who makes a practice of sinning also practices lawlessness; sin is lawlessness. (1 John 3:4)
  - **E. Debt (obligation):** we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh. (Romans 8:12)
- III. A <u>REMEMBERANCE</u> in Forgiveness: "have forgiven"
  - **A.** From The Cross: And Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do." And they cast lots to divide his garments. (Luke 23:34)
  - **B.** Mercy On You: and should not you have had mercy on your fellow servant, as I had mercy on you? (Matthew 18:33)
  - **C.** For If You: but if you do not forgive others trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your tresspasses. (Matthew 6:15)
- IV. A RELEASE in Forgiveness: "our debtors"
  - A. What Forgiveness is NOT!
